About the service

The service provides **information** and **advice** to people in Poole who have had a stroke or Transient Ischemic Attack (TIA), their carers and families. We can also signpost you to other services you may find beneficial.

The **aim** of the service is to ensure you have the **support** you need to make **choices** and **enable** you to live as **independently** as possible after a stroke or TIA.

How the service can help

- Offering emotional support
- **Identifying** and **preventing** further problems
- Providing advice about adjusting to health changes and making
 lifestyle adjustments, to reduce the risks of a further stroke or TIA
- Supporting carers and family members
- Signposting to local stroke groups or community activities
- Helping to access other services such as care management or psychological support
- Providing information about volunteering and activities to get you back to work
- Supporting your well-being
